The fresh, Scandinavian design reflects the colour palette from the sea. The ship is modern and environmentally friendly and we will make further improvements in order to reduce emissions and fuel consumption. The new ship's maneuverability and optimal size makes her very suitable for exploring the coast of Norway. She will also be equipped and adapted for future sailings in polar waters.
